<p><b>Makerspace:</b> <a href="#">Stem activities you can do at home.</a></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Use materials in your home to create an insect habitat.</li> <li>● Go outside and use either paper/pencil or sidewalk chalk to trace a toy's shadow. (Leave the toy there) Go back later, trace it again, and see how the shadow has changed.</li> <li>● Rainbow Flower Experiment- Add water and food coloring to a cup or vase. Add a white flower.
