Special Education and Section 504

PK-12th Grade

Level 1: Traditional School/Seated School with Health Precautions: Students identified in need of special education services or accommodations (Section 504) will be provided accommodations and services according to their current plan.



Level 2: In-School Instruction with Technology Support:

Students will be provided services and accommodations according to their plan with appropriate safety measures in place. Social distancing will be managed by grade level and area of service.

Level 3: Online with Alternative Methods of Instruction: Learning through remote learning programming or distance services not located on campus. Services and accommodations will be provided in accordance with the students IEP or Section 504. Special Education Teachers and/or Case Managers will be the contact person for provision of services. Related service providers will work in conjunction with teachers and parents to provide appropriate services.

Provision of equitable services for students during remote learning:

All services provided will be based on student-specific needs as outlined in his/her IEP or accommodation plan. The services provided will be determined based on decisions made by the multidisciplinary team, which includes the parent/guardian.

- individualized academic task boxes;
- individualized physical therapy task boxes;
- individualized occupational therapy task boxes;
- individualized printed materials to maintain educational growth;
- in-person instruction based on the ability to maintain safety precautions on student need;
- frequent contact with parent/guardian and student by special education; and
- online services to teach new material using a video-conferencing platform.
